WATER SUPPLY POLICY

Water used for both emergency & non-emergency situations will have the source location and quantity recorded and reported to the appropriate agency/district which is responsible for the supply source.

NON-EMERGENCY

Prior to non-emergency operations, the source district/agency shall be contacted to determine supply status/availability.

Water used for training or non-emergency transport will be recorded and reported as stated previously.

ONLY official Fire Dept equipment will be used to connect to and receive water at source locations. Standard tanker operation procedures will be followed at all times.

Once water has been transferred from the source into Fire Dept apparatus it is deemed NON-POTABLE.

Conveyance of water to the general public shall be recorded as tanker shuttle training, and in accordance with source district/agency policy. Receipt showing amount of water purchased will be provided to the Fire District by the end user before operations begin.
